

Inclusive Access

Inclusive Access (IA)

A program that provides automatic access to course materials on the first day of class. Students register for class as usual and receive automatic access through D2L. This program saves students, on average, 60% compared to other purchasing options. IA offers an opt out option for students who choose not to participate. Available for eBooks, interactive courseware, and other education platforms. Available for any UNG course, any campus.

Why Inclusive Access?

Cost of textbooks have increased in recent years and the bookstores have looked for creative ways to save students money. The bookstores negotiate price with the publishers to get the students a lower price.

How does it work?

- Professors will choose all course materials required to be successful for class.
- The bookstore then negotiates price in order to get the cheapest price available.
- After a student registers for a course, they will be an instructions email on how to access their course materials on D2L.
 - Included in this email will be "how to opt-out" and billing instructions.
- Starting day one of classes, students will have access to course materials.
- Once add/drop ends, the bookstores bill students banner account the cost of course materials.

**STUDENTS THAT DROP THE CLASS DURING ADD/DROP WILL BE
OPTED OUT AND NOT BILLED.**

How Students Benefit

- Students will pay less than the cost of physical textbook purchased from the UNG Bookstore.
- Opt-out options available for students. The bookstore understands that everyone has different preferences.
- Starting day one of classes, students will have access to course materials.
- Saves time, money, and stress. There is a ton going on the first week of classes, this is one big item that students will not have to worry about.
- No more waiting for your book to come in and falling behind in class. Day one means day one.

This program is separate from ordering traditional textbooks, ebooks, etc.. If you are still enrolled in IA and have not opted-out, your banner account will be charged.
